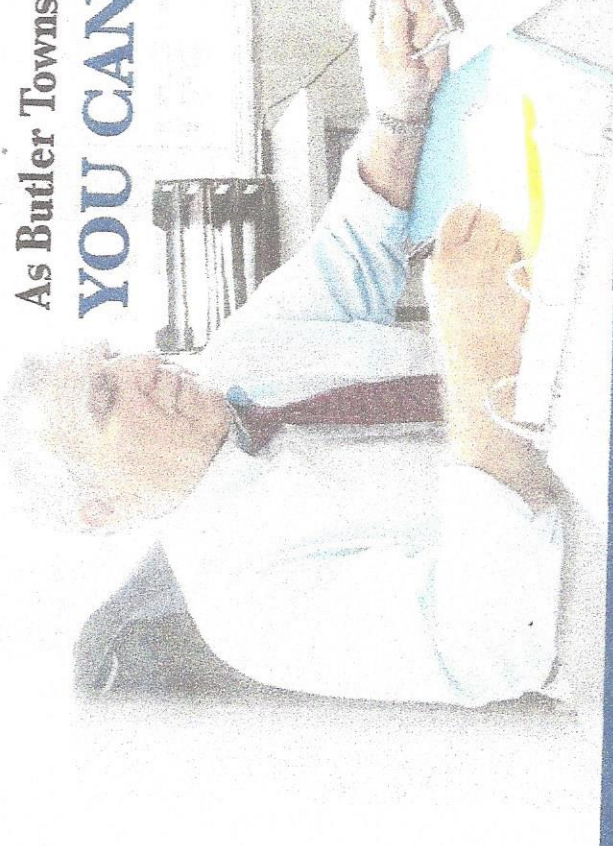
As Butler Township's Next Trustee
