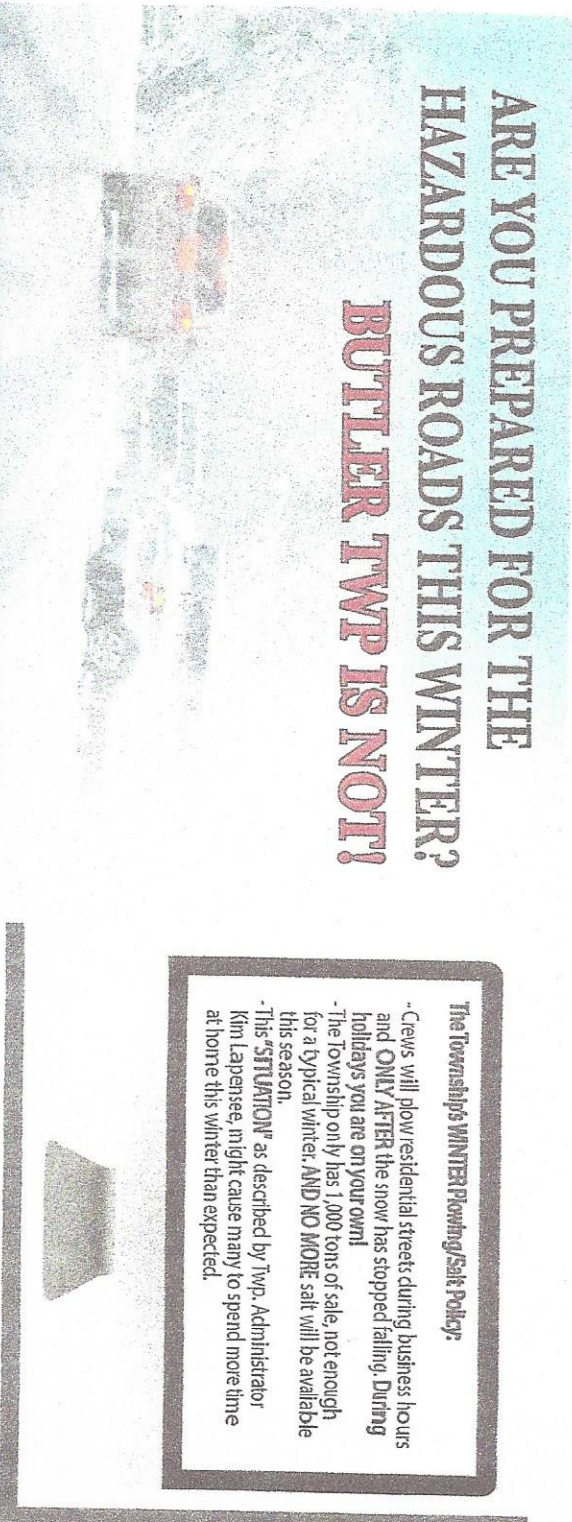

The Township's Winter Plowing/Salt Policy:

- Crews will plow residential streets during business hours and **ONLY AFTER** the snow has stopped falling. During holidays you are on your own!
- The Township only has 1,000 tons of salt, not enough for a typical winter, **AND NO MORE** salt will be available this season.
- This "SITUATION" as described by Twp. Administrator Kim Lapsensee, might cause many to spend more time at home this winter than expected.
